

DBS REQUIREMENTS FOR 2018 SEASONAL STAFF



To comply with our legal obligation to keep young people and staff safe, all seasonal staff are required to have a valid DBS certificate in order to work on the programme.

The policy table below outlines which minimum level of DBS check is necessary for each of our roles:

Role	Minimum Level of Check	Date of Issue
Support Worker	Enhanced Check with Children's and Adult's Barred List Check	After 1st January 2017
Programme Administrator	Basic Check	After 1st January 2017
Programme Leader	Enhanced Check with Children's Barred List Check only	After 1st January 2017
Assistant Programme Leader	Enhanced Check with Children's Barred List Check only	After 1st January 2017
Senior Mentor	Enhanced Check with Children's Barred List Check only	After 1st January 2017
Personal Coach	Enhanced Check with Children's Barred List Check only	After 1st January 2017
Learning & Behaviour Specialist	Enhanced Check with Children's Barred List Check only	After 1st January 2017
Mental Health Adviser	Enhanced Check with Children's Barred List Check only	After 1st January 2017
Workshop Facilitator	Enhanced Check with Children's Barred List Check only	After 1st January 2017
Public Speaking Coach	Enhanced Check with Children's Barred List Check only	After 1st January 2017
Residential Programme Coordinator	Enhanced Check with Children's Barred List Check only	After 1st January 2017
Assistant Programme Manager (Delivery)	Enhanced Check with Children's Barred List Check only	After 1st January 2017
Programme Associate Manager (Delivery)	Enhanced Check with Children's Barred List Check only	After 1st January 2017
Programme Manager (Delivery)	Enhanced Check with Children's Barred List Check only	After 1st January 2017
